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RULES FOR AWARD OF GOLD AND SILVER MEDALS

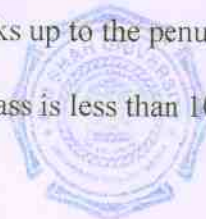
(W. E. F. Academic Year 2022 - 23)

1. Gold Medal:

A Gold Medal shall be awarded to a candidate who fulfils the following conditions:

- 1.1 Minimum requirement for a candidate to be eligible for award of Gold Medal shall be Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 6.50 of all the semesters i.e., overall, first (1st) division, where the result is given in CGPA. In case the result is given only in marks and not in CGPA, minimum requirement for a candidate to be eligible for Gold Medal shall be overall 60 percent marks of all the semesters/years i.e., overall 1st division.
- 1.2 The candidate must have passed the examinations in the regular/normal period of the programme in first attempt in all the semesters/years, i.e., there has been no reappearance/drop in any subject(s) / course(s) during the entire period of his/her study. However, if a candidate has passed the subject(s) after rechecking/re-evaluation/answer book showing of the main examination, then it shall be treated as single attempt and a candidate opting for rechecking/re-evaluation/answer book showing will not be disqualified for any medal. Such re-evaluated/change in marks shall be considered for ascertaining the award of Gold Medal. The final decision for award of Gold Medal shall be taken after completion of rechecking/re-evaluation/answer book showing process of the final semester examination in that particular programme.
- 1.3 The candidate must have fulfilled all the requirement of the programme.
- 1.4 The candidate who has reappeared, in any examination in any of the semesters during the entire period of the programme, on account of absence in any paper/subject shall not be eligible for award of Gold Medal.
- 1.5 The candidate, who has been caught in any unfair means (UFM) in any University examination and has faced any disciplinary action for the same, shall not be eligible for award of Gold Medal.
- 1.6 The candidate, who has secured highest CGPA or highest aggregate marks, amongst eligible candidates, as per criteria 1.1 to 1.5 above, shall be awarded Gold Medal.
- 1.7 In case, two or more candidates have secured the same CGPA/same percentage of marks, the following tie breaking rules in the same order of preference, shall be followed to decide the Gold Medal:
 - a) The candidate who has secured higher CGPA by considering up to 3rd place of decimal of CGPA shall stand higher in rank. In case of the marks, the candidate who has secured higher percentage by considering up to 3rd place of decimal of percentage shall stand higher in rank.
 - b) The candidate, who has secured highest CGPA or highest aggregate marks up to the penultimate semester shall stand higher in rank.
- 1.8 Gold Medal shall not be awarded for those programmes where strength of class is less than 10.

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2. Silver Medal:

A Silver Medal shall be awarded to a candidate who fulfils the following conditions:

- 2.1 Minimum requirement for a candidate to be eligible for award of Silver Medal shall be Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 6.50 of all the semesters i.e., overall, first (1st) division, , where the result is given in CGPA. In case the result is given only in marks and not in CGPA, minimum requirement for a candidate to be eligible for Silver Medal shall be overall 60 percent marks of all the semesters/years i.e., overall 1st division.
- 2.2 The candidate must have passed the examinations in the regular/normal period of the programme in first attempt in all the semesters/years, i.e., there has been no reappearance/drop in any subject(s)/course(s) during the entire period of his/her study. However, if a candidate has passed the subject(s) after rechecking/re-evaluation/answer book showing of the main examination, then it shall be treated as single attempt and a candidate opting for rechecking/re-evaluation/answer book showing will not be disqualified for any medal. Such re-evaluated/change in marks shall be considered for ascertaining the award of Silver Medal. The final decision for award of Silver Medal shall be taken after completion of rechecking/re-evaluation/answer book showing process of the final semester examination in that particular programme.
- 2.3 The candidate must have fulfilled all the requirements of the programme.
- 2.4 The candidate who has reappeared, in any examination in any of the semesters during the entire period of the programme, on account of absence in any paper/subject shall not be eligible for award of Silver Medal.
- 2.5 The candidate, who has been caught in any unfair means (UFM) in any University examination and has faced any disciplinary action for the same, shall not be eligible for award of Silver Medal.
- 2.6 The candidate, who has secured second highest CGPA or second highest aggregate marks, amongst eligible candidates, as per criteria 2.1 to 2.5 above, shall be awarded Silver Medal.
- 2.7 In case, two or more candidates have secured the same CGPA/same percentage of marks, the following tie breaking rules in the same order of preference, shall be followed to decide the Silver Medal:
 - a) The candidate who has secured higher CGPA by considering up to 3rd place of decimal of CGPA shall stand higher in rank. In case of the marks, the candidate who has secured higher percentage by considering up to 3rd place of decimal of percentage shall stand higher in rank.
 - b) The candidate, who has secured second highest CGPA or second highest aggregate marks up to the penultimate semester shall stand higher in rank.
- 2.8 Silver Medal shall not be awarded for those programmes where strength of class is less than 10.

3. General

- 3.1 A Committee comprising of the Provost, the concerned Dean, the Registrar and the Controller of the Examinations will decide the candidates for the Gold Medals and Silver Medals of all the programmes falling in the concerned Faculty. However, the inputs for marking these decisions will be provided by the Examination Section.
- 3.2 Diploma to Degree (D to D) / Transfer / Lateral Entry students shall also be eligible for Gold/Silver Medals as per these rules.
